If they are received in a timely manner, they will be prioritized by the TAC at the April 15 meeting. If not, they will be prioritized by the TAC at the May or subsequent meeting.
- 3. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment for ARRA Funding.**
A TIP amendment may be required for Round 2 applications, possibly as soon as the April or May meeting. If necessary, a TIP amendment project list spreadsheet will be distributed to the TAC after April 8.
- 4. Functional Classification System Update Request.**
Please bring a listing of functional classification updates you would like considered. A coordinated listing will be forwarded to WisDOT for review and consideration.
- 5. 2010 Aerial Photography Program.**
The LAPC is considering acquiring aerial photography in 2010. We are considering 6” photos in the urbanized area and 12” in the rural area. Areas outside the LAPC planning area will be the responsibility of La Crosse, Houston and Winona Counties.
- 6. Traffic Model Update for 2010 Metropolitan Transportation Plan.**
The traffic model is being updated based on the projected development reviewed by the TAC for the 2007 La Crosse County Roadway Plan.
