- 2. LAPC 2017 Local Studies Program.**

About \$72,000 is available for the 2017 LAPC Local Studies Program. Funded local studies are subject to approval by WisDOT for federal and state funding. Studies must be for transportation related purposes and cannot include engineering or project implementation. There will be a 20% local match required, and the studies should be complete by the end of 2017. Please submit local studies proposals by February 15, 2017 so that the TAC can prioritize funding at the March meeting.

- 3. Transportation Demand Management planning.**

LAPC meetings in February, March, and April in 2017 will focus on **LAND USE and POLICIES, PARKING, and TRANSIT**, respectively. Municipalities will report on existing and discuss future projects to implement Transportation Demand Management. At this TAC meeting we will prepare for the parking and transit discussions. Specifically, how is your community prepared to support or implement measures to manage transportation demand related to **LAND USE and POLICIES and PARKING?**

- 4. Coordinated City/County/MPO Planning and Destination Medical Center in Rochester.**

Tom Faella will provide an overview of how land use and transportation planning is coordinated in Rochester, Minnesota with an integrated City, County and MPO planning structure. Mr. Faella will also discuss the Destination Medical Center project in the Rochester area and how it relates to our local Transportation Demand Management discussion.
